If your nomination is successful, your nominee will be invited to become a Barclays Game Changer representing not just their school, but the whole of their Barclays Girls' Football School Partnership. They will require ongoing and regular support from yourself or another dedicated member of school staff throughout the duration of their role.

This will include:

- Ensuring access to the online training provided the initial training will be managed in small groups and will take place live online (via zoom), this will be during the school day, with a recommendation that it is during a lunchtime. It is imperative that you can support the young person to access the training sessions.
- On completion of training follow up will be needed with BGFSP Strategic Lead to agree an action plan, this must then be sent home and a signed copy received back to you from the parent/guardians.
- Regular check-ins with the young person and BGFSP Strategic Lead on progress.
 Ongoing support from you will be really crucial for the success of the young person in this role and to raise and manage any concerns when they arise so please consider how this will be managed. As a minimum we would expect you to have a conversation with the young person at least every fortnight to check-in. You will be provided with a log sheet to capture notes from these check-ins which could be a quick conversation or a more formal session depending on need.
